



a) Club Boat and Trips

1. All divers, who have the intention to dive off any boat taken on a club trip, will reimburse the Club at the rate of £2 per day, per diver,
2. Launch fees/tractor fees/boat petrol is to be paid by people using the boat (non diving Cox is exempt). These fees are to be averaged out over the duration of the trip and are to be divided between the total number of dives using the boat (or intention thereof), per person.
3. Divers will not be charged for expenses relating to boat diving where any dive is aborted due to mechanical and/or electrical failure of the boat.
4. 50% of the boat tower's cost of fuel will be divided equally between the divers on the trip. The boat tower will also receive, from the Club, £10 for towing within a 200 mile radius, £15 above 200 miles, one way only.
5. Accommodation will dictate the number of spaces available on club trips. Full diving members to take priority, followed by social members and then non members. Non members may be subject to an additional administration charge.

b) Instructor and Course Refunds

1. 50% of all successfully attained BSAC instructor training schemes to be re-funded by the Club upon completion of 5 training events per individual training scheme.
2. Funding of all other courses beneficial to the Club will be decided on their individual merit after application, in writing, to the Committee.
3. The Club will reimburse Open Water Instructors and above the cost of their membership at Stoney Cove on completion of one instruction dive at Stoney upon production of proof of payment and the appropriate Dive Log Sheet.

c) Equipment Hire

1. Each section of hire kit to be £1.50 plus cost of air for pool training, unless all sections are hired at once then a discounted price of £7.50 (including air) will be charged.
2. Those lending kit for use by trainees should be reimbursed equal to the Club hire rates, when there is no Club kit available.
3. Instructors do not have to pay equipment hire fees when giving training at the pool. Use of equipment by Instructors is subject to availability, with priority for equipment hire to be given to trainees.



d) Membership

1. Any member of the Club considering changing their membership status should address a letter of application and explanation to the Committee for approval. The Committee would not be expecting an active diver to apply for Social Membership.
2. Non members of Scubonaut Diving Club to be charged 'guest' pool fees.
3. A £10 joining fee will be charged to all new members. Members who rejoin after a lapsed time may be subject to this £10 joining fee at the discretion of the Committee.
4. Qualification books and medicals need to be updated in the master records, regularly.
5. All new members will be required to accept the Club's Welfare Policy upon joining. Members, as at 1 May 2009, are deemed to have accepted the policy dated April 2009).

e) Finance

1. The majority of the Club's monetary assets to be kept in an interest earning bank/building society account.
2. AT LEAST once in every year, the accounts of Scubonaut Diving Club should be examined and the correctness of the income and expenditure account and balance sheet ascertained by two separate and independent Auditors.
